- o Estimates were received from Parkson Corp. to rebuild the diffuser.
 - Councilman Smith motioned and Councilman Collins seconded the motion to approve the quote from Parkson Corp. in the amounts of \$6,433 and \$3,600 to repair and rebuild the diffuser. All present were in favor. Motion passed.
- A quote was received from Exeter Supply for a grinder pump at the sewer plant in the amount of \$194.80.
 - A motion was made by Councilman Whitney and Seconded by Councilman Van Gorden to approve the quote for a grinder pump in the amount of \$1,948.00 from Exeter Supply. All present were in favor. Motion passed.
- Councilman Whitney motioned and Councilman Smith seconded to send new employees to the water certification classes being held in Potter County. All present were in favor. Motion passed.
- > DPW Report: The new skid steer has been in for repairs six times since it was purchased. Gravel is being used to build a new road across Egleston's property to access topsoil pit.
