

DRINKING WATER PROBLEM CORRECTED

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

ESTE INFORME CONTIENE INFORMACIÓN IMPORTANTE ACERCA DE SU AGUA POTABLE. HAGA QUE ALGUIEN LO TRADUZCA PARA USTED, O HABLE CON ALGUIEN QUE LO ENTIENDA.

As a customer of ELKALND BOROUGH AUTHORITY, you were notified on 01/29/26 of a problem with our drinking water and were advised to not serve water to infants 6 months or younger. We are happy to say, that with confirmation samples that this public notification is effect.

- The confirmation sample on 2/3/26 (0.259 mg/L, analyzed today) as a standalone result does not exceed the Ten-Day HAL for children under 6 months (0.3 mg/L), the One-Day HAL for the entire population (1 mg/L), or the lifetime HAL for population older than 6 months (0.3 mg/L).
- The average between the January Entry Point #101 sample which exceeded the Ten-Day HAL (0.355 mg/L, analyzed 1/29/26) and this confirmation sample from Entry Point #101 (0.259 mg/L, analyzed today) equates to 0.307 mg/L, which also does not exceed any HALs.
- In the distribution system, a complete water turnover and replacement occurred through unintentional flushing 1/31/26-2/1/26, when a main break dewatered the storage tank and distribution system.
